

ACTIVITIES

MEETINGS: The DelVal Turners meet every 2nd Tuesday of each month. A six month rolling schedule is established by the club leaders. Meeting topics include show and tell, demonstrations, discussions on various turning related subjects, such as tool sharpening, sanding, finishing, chucks, jigs, marketing your crafts etc. New members are encouraged to contribute new ideas to help create an interesting and challenging program.
